Thank you for choosing the Carl 4-Hole Heavy Duty Punch No. 124N Please carefully read these Instructions before using your punch to obtain best results. File this instruction sheet safely for furture reference.

_Cautions

injury may occur through mis-use.



DO NOT lower the handle when hand or fingers are beneath the punching blade.



DO NOT allow small children to use the machine and ensure that it is kept out of reach of children when not in use.



DO NOT attempt to modify the operations of the machine.

To ensure that your machine operates effectively:



FOR BEST USE always ensure that the machine is in a stable environment before commencing to punch.



Only use the Carl 124MD punching blade.



Ensure that clips and staples are removed from the area to be punched before use.



Clean out the paper waste tray from time to time.



Punch should only be used for perforating paper.



Paper volumes should bot be more than specified on the instruction sheet.




Rotate the punching disk from time to time allowing the blade to punch onto an unused portion of the punching disk



Once the punching disk has been fully used replace with a new punching disk.



To Use the Punch

- (i) Lift up the handle.
- (ii) Use the built-in side-paper gauge to set the paper punching position.
- (iii) Once papers are set press the handle downward to punch. Ensure that the punching blade is completely through to the punching disk.
- (iv) Once punching is complete the handle should be lifted to retract the paper.


To Set the Paper Position



- (i) Place the paper on the base
- (ii) Align the paper to the left-position at the side paper gauge.




Press the papers firmly to the back wall.



 Punching blade and paper gauge are set for A4 size.

Paper Waste




 Pull out the paper waste tray, open the lid and discard the waste.



The paper waste tray should be cleaned out from time to time.

If blades seem to be dull


Rotation of the position of punching blades



· If you feel blade becomes dull, rotate the punching disk in use from time to time.

Do not place your hands under blades. (It may result in injury.)


Replacement of the Punching disk



 Once circumference of the punching disk is all damaged, replace the punching disk.

Do not place your hands under blades. (It may result in injury.)

Replacement of the punching blades




 Once the punching blade has become blunt, it should be replaced.

Turn the screw counter clockwise to expose the punching blade.

Replace the old punching blade with the new one.



Do not touch the point of the blade. (It may result in injury.)
